


# Big Bend National Park

## Weather Forecast

Today..... Sunny! Patchy fog in the morning. Mountain highs in the upper 50's, river & desert highs in the upper 70's. Northeast winds around 10 mph in the afternoon.

Tonight..... Increasing clouds. Lows in the lower 50's. Northeast winds around 10 mph.

Tomorrow ..... Mostly cloudy. Mountain highs in the mid 60's, river & desert in the lower 80's. Southwest winds around 10 mph. Mostly cloudy evening. Lows in the upper 50's.

Extended..... Friday - Tuesday: Mostly cloudy then clearing. Possible rain Friday overnight.

Highs: upper 50's - lower 90's                      Lows: upper 40's to mid 50's

Sunset tonight: 6:39 p.m. .... Sunrise tomorrow: 7:34 a.m.
