


Big Bend National Park

Tonight Mostly clear. Lows 44 - 49.
Tomorrow Mostly cloudy. Mountain highs around 60, river & desert in the upper 70's. Southwest winds 10 mph. 20% chance of showers. Evening lows in the mid 50's.
Extended..... Monday - Wednesday: Mostly cloudy to mostly sunny. Chance of rain some days.
Highs: lower 60's - lower 80's Lows: low 50's
