Weather Forecast

Today..... Partly cloudy. Mountain highs in the upper 60's, river & desert highs in the mid 80's.
Light and variable winds.

Tonight..... Mostly cloudy. Lows in the upper 50's. 20% chance of showers after midnight.

Tomorrow Mostly cloudy. Showers likely in the afternoon. Mountain highs in the lower 60's, river & desert in the upper 70's. South winds 10 mph. Evening lows in the lower 50's.

Extended..... Wednesday - Sunday: Sunny becoming mostly cloudy then clearing again.
Highs: lower 60's - mid 80's Lows: upper 40's to mid 50's
Sunset tonight: 6:38 p.m. Sunrise tomorrow: 7:36 a.m.
