Weather Forecast

Today..... Sunny. Mountain highs in the upper 70's, river & desert highs around 100. Southeast wind 10 mph.

Tonight..... Mostly cloudy, chance of rain. Lows in the upper 60's. East winds 10 - 20 mph.

Tomorrow Sunny. Mountain highs in the upper 70's, river & desert highs in the upper 90's. South winds 10 - 20 mph. Chance of rain then clearing in the evening lows in the mid 60's.

Extended..... Wednesday - Sunday: Sunny to mostly cloudy. Chance of rain and thunderstorms.
Highs: mid 70's to mid 100's Lows: mid 60's to mid 70's

Current Park Conditions:

*** RT 16 (road to Santa Elena Canyon) is closed due to flooding. Old Maverick closed due to flooding. Pending road updates.

*** Heat safety tips: Avoid strenuous activity between 12 PM and 8 PM. Protect yourself from the sun, wear lightweight, light-colored protective clothing, a hat and sunscreen. Drink plenty of water and supplement with electrolytes. Carry a minimum of 2 liters for short hikes, and 1 gallon or more for full-day hikes. Eat salty snacks and take frequent breaks in the shade to cool down.

* High clearance, 4-wheel drive vehicles are required on Maverick Road, Old Ore Road, River Road, and Terlingua Ranch Road, & recommended on all other primitive roads. Black Gap is closed. Expect rough and/or muddy conditions on all gravel and/or dirt roads.
